

Freedom Scriptures from God's Word!

Isaiah 53:1 (KJV)

1 **Who** hath **believed our report?** and to **whom** is the arm of the LORD revealed?

1 Peter 5:7 (AMP)

7 Casting the whole of your care [**all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all**] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.

Romans 8:25 (AMP)

25 But if we hope for what is still unseen by us, we wait for it **with patience and composure.**

Romans 8:25 (NKJV)

25 But if we hope for what we do not see, we **eagerly wait** for it with **perseverance.**

Proverbs 16:3 (AMP)

3 **Roll** your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established and succeed.

Proverbs 1:33 (NKJV)

33 But whoever listens to me will dwell safely, And will be secure, **without fear of evil.**"

Proverbs 1:33 (AMP)

33 But whoso hearkens to me [Wisdom] shall dwell securely and in confident trust and shall be quiet, **without fear or dread of evil.**

Proverbs 1:33 (TLB)

33 But all who listen to me shall live in peace and safety, **unafraid.**"

Proverbs 1:33 (MSG)

33 First pay attention to me, and then **relax.** Now you can **take it easy—****you're in good hands.**"

John 10:27-30 (MSG)

27 My sheep recognize my voice. I know them, and they follow me.

28 I give them real and eternal life. They are protected from the Destroyer for good. **No one can steal them from out of my hand.**

29 The Father who put them under my care is so much greater than the Destroyer and Thief. No one could ever get them away from him.

30 I and the Father are one heart and mind."

Proverbs 11:23 (NKJV)

23 The desire (Dict. Longing) of the righteous is **only good**, But the expectation of the wicked is wrath.

Proverbs 11:23 (RSV)

23 The desire of the righteous **ends only in good**; the expectation of the wicked in wrath.

1 Peter 2:23 (AMP)

23 When He was reviled and insulted, He did not revile or offer insult in return; [when] He was abused and suffered, He made no threats [of vengeance]; but **he trusted [Himself and everything] to Him** Who judges fairly.

1 Peter 2:23 (TLB)

23 never answered back when insulted; when he suffered he did not threaten to get even; **he left his case in the hands of God** who always judges fairly.

Romans 5:3-5 (AMP)

3 Moreover [let us also be full of joy now!] **let us exult and triumph in our troubles and REjoice** in our sufferings, knowing that pressure and affliction and hardship produce patient and unswerving endurance.

4 And endurance (fortitude) develops maturity of character (approved faith and tried integrity). And character [of this sort] produces [the habit of] joyful and confident hope of eternal salvation.

5 Such hope never disappoints or deludes or shames us, for God's love has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit Who has been given to us.

Romans 5:3-5 (TLB)

3 We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, **for we know that they are good for us—they help us learn to be patient.**

4 And patience develops strength of character in us and helps us trust God more each time we use it until finally our hope and faith are strong and steady.

5 Then, when that happens, we are able to hold our heads high no matter what happens and know that all is well, for we know how dearly God loves us, and we feel this warm love everywhere within us because God has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love.

Romans 8:28 (RSV)

28 We know that **in everything God works for good** with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:28 (TLB)

28 And we know **that all that happens to us is working for our good** if we love God and are fitting into his plans.

Ephesians 5:1 (AMP)

1 THEREFORE BE imitators of God [**copy Him** and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father].

Romans 4:17 (RSV)

17 as it is written, "I have made you the father of many nations" -- in the presence of the God in whom he believed, who gives life to the dead and **calls into existence the things that do not exist.**

Romans 4:17 (NKJV)

17 (as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed--God, who gives life to the dead and **calls those things which do not exist as though they did;**

Romans 10:10 (RSV)

10 For man **believes with his heart** and so is justified, and he **confesses with his lips and so is saved.**

Romans 10:10 (NKJV)

10 For **with the heart one believes** unto righteousness, and **with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.**
